### **Scholarships and Awards:**

Miss Strassenfest receives a \$1,000 scholarship, tiara, and an opportunity to represent Jasper and earn additional scholarships in the Indiana State Festivals Association pageant. 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-Up receives \$500, 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-Up, Miss Congeniality, and Miss Photogenic titles will also be awarded and receive prizes. All title-winners will represent Jasper during the 2020 Jasper Strassenfest and throughout the year of reign.

### **Dates:**

Photos: Contestants will have their photo taken at McCarty's studio the week of June 8. Date will be announced shortly. Photos will be used by the judges in determining the title of Miss Photogenic.

First Rehearsal: First Rehearsal will be held Thursday, July 9, 2020 from 6:00-8:00pm at Redemption Christian Church in Jasper, IN. No food allowed at rehearsals – only water bottles.

Dress Rehearsal: Dress Rehearsal will be held Friday, July 24, 2020 from 5:30-8:30pm at Redemption Christian Church in Jasper, IN. Contestants will need to bring all outfits/shoes that will be worn in the pageant. During Dress Rehearsal, contestants will receive two complimentary tickets to the pageant. Public tickets will be sold at the door before the pageant. No food allowed at rehearsals – only water bottles.

Pageant: The Strassenfest Pageant (Miss, Jr. Miss, Little Miss and Mister) will be held Saturday, July 25, 2020 from 3:00-5:00pm at Redemption Christian Church in Jasper, IN. Miss Contestants will need to be available the morning of the pageant as well.

### **Categories of Competition:**

The pageant is divided into five categories: Interview, Introduction, Fashion Walk, Community Involvement, and Evening Gown/Onstage Question. The morning of the pageant, contestants will participate in an interview with a panel of 3 non-local judges to discuss the Strassenfest and items listed on the contestant's application. Onstage during the pageant, contestants will introduce themselves, model the outfit they choose from Just Whimsy, discuss their Community Involvement Project, and do a final walk in their evening gown before answering a simple on-stage question. Titles will be announced at the conclusion of the pageant.

### **Community Involvement:**

Contestants are asked to volunteer a minimum of six hours with the community organization of their choice before First Rehearsal (July 9).
