



Little Miss and Mister Strassenfest receive various gifts donated by our local community vendors and the opportunity to represent the pageant throughout the Strassenfest event. The Little Strassenfest court will also be awarded and receive special gifts.

The pageant will consist of two segments for the Little Miss and Mister contestants: an meeting with the judges prior to onstage events and then an onstage Introduction and onstage interview. During the introduction, each contestant will be asked to say their name, age, their parent's names and the school they attend. During the onstage interview, each contestant will be asked to answer a question. A list of potential questions asked will be provided prior to the pageant.

### **COVID PRECAUTIONS**

Masks will be worn by all participants, judges, and coordinators at all times during practices and backstage. Participants can remove their mask on stage and during the interview when social distancing is in place.

### **German/Fest Attire:**

Contestants are asked to wear age appropriate German/fest attire for pictures and the pageant. Little Miss Contestants should wear a traditional Dirndl. Little Mister Contestants should wear traditional Lederhosen. Attire does not need to be specially made for the pageant. Our community is a great resource and attire can often be borrowed from our friends and neighbors who have had Littles participate in the past.

### **Pictures and Practice:**

Photos will be taken at a to-be-determined time and location. Little Miss and Mister contestants photos will be done alphabetically and time slots will be sent out prior to the week of photos. There will be a group photo in the middle of individual photos. Each contestant is asked to wear the German/fest attire that will be worn during the pageant.

Dress rehearsal will be on July 30th from 5:30 - 6:30pm. We will meet at the Redemption Christian Church. **Please Note: DO NOT enter the church or walk the stage prior to the first dress rehearsal, as the church may have other events going on.** This will be a dress rehearsal, so please wear the German/fest attire and shoes to this rehearsal. We should finish rehearsal around 6:30PM. Tickets are available for purchase on this day. Each contestant will receive two complimentary tickets and may purchase additional tickets for \$5 per ticket. Please make checks payable to Jasper Strassenfest. Tickets will be sold at the door the night of the pageant.

Please be sure to eat before practice. Bringing bottled water is encouraged during rehearsal.

### **Pageant day:**

On Saturday, July 31st, the contestants should arrive at the Redemption Christian Church by 1PM, dressed and ready to go in German/fest attire. The Little contestants will meet the judges from 1:20pm to 1:50pm. The Pageant begins at 2:00PM on July 31st.

Eight titles will awarded that evening: Little Miss/Mister, 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up Little Miss/Mister, 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up Little Miss/Mister, Best German Attire Little Miss/Mister

### **Strassenfest Parade:**

Contestants and Littles Court will be asked to ride on the float during the Parade on Sunday, August 8th.
