The Glockenspiel

A NEW STRASSENFEST TRADITION

A traditional Glockenspiel is a German musical instrument with a clock that chimes the hour and triggers mechanical figures that perform a dance.

The Strassenfest Glockenspiel features a clock. The children performers from May Pole, Willkommen and Kinderchor, chime the hour and perform a dance on the Glockenspiel balcony. Audience participates in the toast to the performers.

Strongest Town JASPER WINS 2022 STRONGEST **TOWN CONTEST**

The foundation of a strong town or city is about community involvement, support, and investing into one's community for the benefit of all the residents. In February 2022, Jasper was nominated into an annual contest to name the Strongest Town in North America. The contest, in its seventh year, is organized by Strong Towns, a non-profit organization, founded in 2008 by Charles Marohn with decades of experience as a civil engineer and urban planner. The Strong Towns approach relies on incremental fiscally responsible investments, focusing on improving what is already present, and builds on resilience while improving quality of life.

The contest was set up like a basketball tournament with towns competing from across the country. As one of the 16 teams chosen in the first round by the Strong Towns organization, Jasper first competed against Brighton, MI, then Champaign, IL, Yellow Springs, OH, and finally against Norwood, OH in the finals before being named the 2022 Strongest Town contest winner.

During the competition, Jasper was able to profile its great guality of life assets. These include the Jasper Riverwalk, Jasper Train Depot and the Spirit of Jasper train excursions, the Jasper City Mill, the Parklands of Jasper, and the Thyen-Clark Cultural Center. The Courthouse Square Infrastructure and Revitalization project as well as the Impact Jasper Comprehensive Plan and the City of Jasper Multimodal Transportation Plan were touted. The work of the Mayor's Youth Council, the Heart of Jasper, TRONG and Dubois County Tourism

were celebrated.

The theme also emphasizes the continued commitment to keep German heritage at the heart of what makes the Jasper Strassenfest such a fun and unique festival.

Jim, a talented carpenter, stone carver and woodcarver, volunteered 2 years of his time to construct the Glockenspiel. In addition to the amazing design and quality craftsmanship of the physical structure, Jim hand carved the two snails and the Deutscher Verein logo that appears on the Glockenspiel. Jim's previous projects include the German Maypole located at the corner of Sixth and Newton streets in Jasper, a wood carved snail on display in Pfaffenweiler, Germany. He was also instrumental in the construction of the Strassenfest German Club booths.

Rita brought her design talents in color, style, balance and floral arrangements to the Glockenspiel. She is a past member of the Strassenfest Committee and performed the May Pole Dance with other members of the German Club during those years.

Jim and Rita Corn have been members of the Deutscher Verein for over 40 years serving in various leadership and support roles in the club. They were previously recognized for their commitment to building German Roots in Dubois County as recipients of the German Heritage Award in 2014.






